

PSALM 63 THE BOOK OF PSALMS

- **LET'S TALK**

What's the most amazing thing you've ever seen?

A Psalm of David when he was in the wilderness. Some suggest he was on the run from Saul as indicated in 1 Samuel 23:14 and some suggest he was on the run from his son Absalom as indicated in 2 Samuel 15.

In verse one, David's search for God is described with the word earnestly. The Hebrew word is defined as to look early and diligently for. What do you look early and diligently for (be honest, no Sunday School answers)?

In verse two David shares about his experience in seeing God. How have you seen God in a way that was unmistakably Him?

David describes his expressions to God as outwardly visible with his lips in words of praise and song. He also describes his response in the lifting of his hands. What's your experience with outwardly visible expressions to God, either individually or corporately?

In verse three David declares God's love as better than life. Have you experienced God's loving kindness, mercy and favor (words that describe the Hebrew word) in a way that superseded everything else? If so, how? Is experiencing God's love of this level challenging for you?

Why does being in the wilderness matter in relation to experiencing God on a profound level.

What would you like to bring before God in prayer?
