

# PSALM 67      THE BOOK OF PSALMS

- **LET'S TALK**

Talk about someone God put in your life to help you understand who He is.

Psalms 67 is sometimes overlooked and not typically a known favorite. Some consider it a “missionary Psalm” due to the identification of God’s mission that He and salvation be experienced among all nations.

The author is seeking God’s favor, mercy, and blessing. In what areas of your life do you need God’s favor, mercy, and blessing (be specific)?

Where are you recognizing His favor, mercy, and blessing? Dive deeper into more than just meeting your natural needs.

In verse two, the author identifies the scope of the mission of God of His being known and salvation among all nations. What’s your understanding of your role in this mission?

The author is seeking favor, mercy, and blessing not for his self-desires but that God’s ways be known and for salvation among the nations. What’s your experience with praying for God to be known and for the salvation of others?

How are you praying for salvation for the people in your web of influence who don’t know God? How are you intentionally seeking ways for God to use you to reveal Himself to those that don’t know him?

The author calls us to praise God, be glad, and sing for joy. How and in what ways do you express praise and adoration to God for who He is and how He’s caring for you?

What would you like to bring before God through prayer?
